What is Operation Red Nose?

Operation Red Nose is a free, confidential, volunteer service where clients are driven home in their own vehicle by a team of volunteers.

What Does An Operation Red Nose Team Do?

You could be part of a three-member team that picks up clients who call the service for a ride. The team drives to the pick-up location in an escort car. One team member (Driver), accompanied by a second team member (Navigator) for safety reasons, drives the client and any passengers to the destination of their choice, in the client's car. The third team member (Escort) follows in the escort car and at the end of the trip, takes the whole team on to the next call. Teams communicate with headquarters via their cell phones.

Each team will consist of:

- * An escort Driver (Driver's Licence required, Minimum age requirement is 19 years)
- * A designated Driver (Driver's Licence required, Minimum age requirement is 21 years)
- A navigator (Driver's Licence Not required, Minimum age requirement is 19 years)

The evening:

- * Volunteers meet at the headquarters, La Route du Savoir, 711 Dalton ave. at 8:30 pm.
- A brief orientation session will begin around 9 pm.
- * Volunteers will be offered a variety of snacks, coffee and more provided by our generous sponsors during the evening.

We hope you'll join us this holiday season and help make Kingston a safer community!
